There is now an online option for giving tithes and offerings!

1) Go to the church's website www.17scc.com and click on the **GIVE ONLINE** tab.

2) Select or type the amount being given in the **Give** box.

Choose the fund to which the contribution is to go in the drop-down box beside the **Give** box.

3) Choose the frequency (one time or regularly) in the **Frequency** box.

If choosing regularly, select a frequency option: weekly, every other week, monthly, or twice monthly. Also choose the day of the week and the date of the donation if opting for a regular donation.

4) Type **Email** address and **Name** in corresponding boxes.

5) Click the **Continue** tab

6) Scroll to the **Select payment method** and add either bank account or debit/credit card information.

All information regarding tithing/giving is confidential and will only be seen by the Treasurer.

Tithing boxes will still remain in the sanctuary for those who wish to tithe using cash or checks.
